2. Important Points in the Application Process

- (1) First, contact and consult with your preferred faculty advisor. Have them sign or put their seal in the remarks column of your application form before you submit it.
- (2) Prior to applying, pay your entrance examination fee by bank transfer.
- (3) Once you have the documents listed in pages 35-37, place the documents in and complete the required information on the pre-addressed "Application Documents Enclosed" envelope and send by post, or bring it in person to the Admissions Section by the appointed time. The office is open weekdays from 9 am-5 pm. Please note that entrance examination fees may not be paid in cash.
- (4) In principle, entrance examination fees are not refundable once you have submitted your application, nor are admission documents returned.

3. Applicant Eligibility

International students who meet the Graduate School of Veterinary Medicine Course eligibility requirements given in the Rakuno Gakuen University Graduate School Admissions Guidelines, as well as meet the following conditions, may apply. Please be aware, however, that no applicant will be considered who has not first consulted with a supervisory faculty member in the relevant research field.

- (1) The applicant is not a Japanese citizen and satisfies conditions a. or b. as well as c.
[Doctoral Course]
 - a. The applicant is a citizen of a country other than Japan and has either completed a six year course of study in veterinary medicine at a university outside of Japan or holds a

master's degree awarded by a university outside of Japan.

- b. The applicant is recognized, via the individual applicant screening process performed by the graduate school, as possessing academic ability at least equivalent to a university graduate (who has completed a six year course of study in veterinary medicine, medicine, dental medicine or pharmaceutical sciences) and will be 24 years old by the date of admission.
- c. The applicant has received or is eligible to receive status of residence as a "Student" in Japan as specified in the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.

[Master's Course]

- a. The applicant is a citizen of a country other than Japan and has completed 16 years of formal education.
- b. The applicant is recognized, via the individual applicant screening process performed by the graduate school, as possessing academic ability at least equivalent to a university graduate and will be 22 years old by the date of admission.
- c. The applicant has received or is eligible to receive status of residence as a "Student" in Japan as specified in the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.

6. Selection Method

Applicants will be screened and selected based upon the documents they submit.

If it is deemed necessary, additional documents or information may be required of applicants on a case-by-case basis. A face-to-face interview or written examination may also be required of applicants.

Caution about foreign students working part-time

Students who intend to do part-time work whilst studying at our university, are first required to familiarize themselves with general knowledge about Japanese society and customs, with the support of the Extension Center and/or a faculty member. Students must complete this familiarization period which takes at least three months. They can then apply for part-time work.

7. Entrance Examination Fee: ¥30,000

- (1) Put your admission application, photo sheet, entrance examination fee receipt, and entrance examination fee transfer request forms together. Fill in the information required, take it to a financial institution, and make an electronic payment.
- (2) Please note that cash, postal transfer, check, etc. are not acceptable forms of payment.
- (3) Confirm that the stamp of the financial institution where you paid is noted on the Photo Sheet. The stamp must be present to prove that you have paid your entrance examination fee.
- (4) Be sure to keep your entrance examination fee receipt. It serves as verification in case your admission application, examination admission ticket, etc. fail to arrive.
- (5) Note that no refunds are provided on entrance examination fees once they have been paid.

- d. Applicants who have taken the Examination for the Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) or the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) within two years of their application.

- Please make sure to submit the copy of the certificate of the remittance (receipt) issued by the bank, along with the other application documents.
